“Lemons on Friday”

After being married for less than a year, country music legend Alan Jackson’s daughter, Mattie was faced with navigating a future that didn’t include her young husband and their lifelong plans.



Twenty-eight-year-old Mattie had to find a way to move forward and reconcile herself with a good God, even when He did not give her the healing miracle she prayed for.

In *Lemons on Friday*, readers walk with Mattie Jackson Selecman during the first years of grief following Ben’s tragic death as she grapples with her loss and leans on a steadfast God.

Based on Selecman’s journal writings, *Lemons on Friday* will speak to all readers who must carry on without their loved ones and take a hard look at faith when their lives have not gone as planned.

- Who’s to blame?
- What could I have done differently?

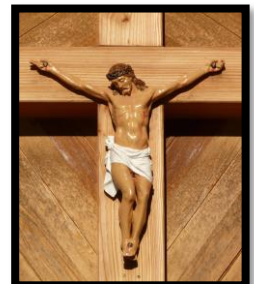
