**Proposed changes to the
Castile United Church of Christ Constitution & By Laws:**

UNDER ARTICLE VIII. BOARDS and COMMITTEES

3. Perpetual Fund Committee:

THIS LINE WOULD BE ELIMINATED: *A Board of Directors consisting of eight (8) persons shall administer the fund. Each year, two (2) directors will be elected to three (3) year terms. Two (2) directors are to be selected from the Board of Trustees.*

THESE would then be under Trustees:

1. The church treasurer shall be the fiscal officer responsible for the depositing, withdrawal and handling of the funds.
2. Eighty-five percent (85%) of the yield may be used annually. Income is to be divided between the Operations and Missions Funds of the church in the following percentages: 60% operational, 40% Missions.
3. The preferred investments for the trust are insured savings accounts and government instruments. Alternative investment vehicles must be approved by the Perpetual Fund Committee.
4. Income may be withdrawn within one (1) year of becoming accessible. Income not withdrawn within one (1) year becomes part of the corpus of the trust and cannot be withdrawn thereafter.
5. Funds may be borrowed from the corpus to cover shortfalls in other church funds. All borrowing must be approved by the Perpetual Fund Committee. All funds borrowed must be repaid to the corpus within eighteen (18) months from the date borrowed.
6. All changes to this document must be approved by the church membership before enactment.

We will be voting on these changes at the

Annual Meeting on January 21st, 2018.
